The Town of Jamestown is located in Boone County in Central Indiana. The utility was established in 1917 and currently serves over 542 meters providing electric, water, wastewater, sanitation, and streets.

Jamestown's wastewater department completed a \$1.6 Million Wastewater project. The project included a new main lift station, converted to UV treatment, new sludge system and completely updated the electrical panels.

Jamestown received an OCRA grant that provided \$600,000 for a large storm water project that is going out for bid later this month. The project will include ditch improvements, underground drainage and an above ground swale construction.

Utility Superintendent, Bobby Taylor has been with Jamestown since 2013. Bobby has many years of experience in the Utility industry primarily working in water / wastewater before transitioning into becoming a lineworker. He completed his apprenticeship training with IMEA and shared his appreciation for all of the education and resources that have been offered to him through the IMEA.
