The City of Auburn and Auburn Electric Utilities have a few new projects underway. Beginning with a new 3 phase overhead line to complete a loop to the Auburn Community new Astral Senior Living Complex with 304 rooms west of the interstate. Also completed, was a new installation to an underground infrastructure along with fiber optic that was provided to (21 lots) of residential property. The Auburn Utility had Wood Poles inspected for their entire system and found 310 rejects with replacing 280 poles, over 90 % pole replacement. Kudos to Auburn for completing all work by the Utility alone! Job well done!
