New Ross Town Hall: Project Development

The Town was established in 1941 and currently serves 217 residential meters. The Town utilities consist of both water and sanitation. New Ross Electric purchased power is provided through IMPA (Indiana Municipal Power Agency) and all electric systems are maintained by IMPA.

The town is currently working on construction of a long awaited wastewater project to upgrade the system. This is being funded fully through a grant provided the town. Some potential upcoming projects will be to replace their current electric meters with smart meters in which will offer time and error reduction for the Town. This has not yet been determined for approval but is looking in favor to consider.

A Long Time Member of IMEA

IMEA offers many valuable resources to the membership but the one resource that truly stands out the most for the Town of New Ross is Mutual Aid and Staff Training. Ashley believes that many can play part in the assistance of neighbor helping neighbor but if that neighbor is mutually dealing with the same difficulties it is always good to know that you can contact the IMEA to coordinate and construct a plan for natural disaster assistance. This way they can contact and create a resolution for all utilities involved.
