Newest Endeavor After Retirement

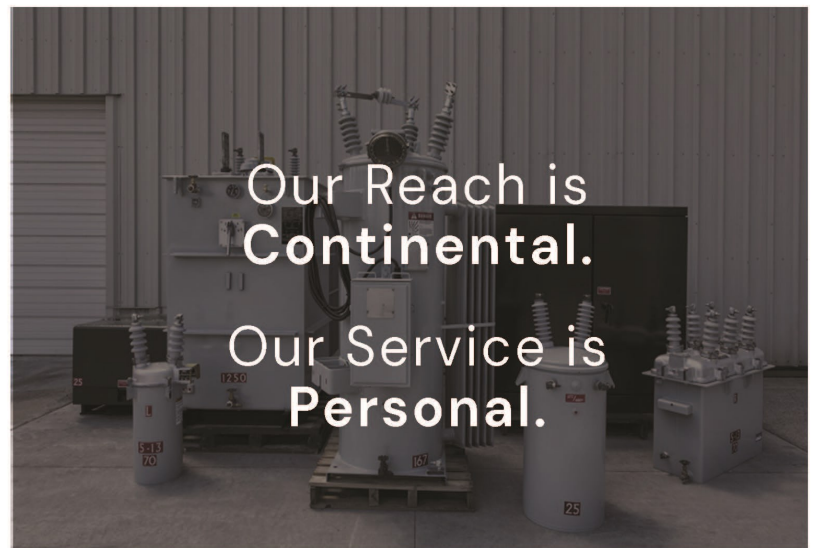
