List of most common Safety Shadows:

- ① Improper Tool for the job
- ① Incorrect PPE
- Failure to use PPE
- Working outside of the work package
- ② Improper Work Set-up
- ① Improper walking/working surfaces
- Slips/Trips/Falls
- Poor Housekeeping
- Un-reviewed Safety Concerns
- Unresolved Hazards
- Incomplete JHA
- Working in Proximity of others-not planned
- ① Hazards not defined or identified
- Overhead Electrical Hazards
- Underground Hazards
- Failure to conduct a Pre-Job Safety Briefing
- ① Inadequate work planning
- Hurried Work
- ① Incomplete supplies/equipment
- ① Ineffective emergency response
- ① Lack of training/information/competency
- Poor Ergonomic Set Up
- Tools used incorrectly-no saw horses/corded tools in wet conditions
- ② Struck by/Struck Against
- ② Pinch Points/Caught Between
