Top 10 OSHA Violations of 2023

The preliminary Top 10 OSHA Violations of 2023 have been announced. This year's OSHA top 10 list accounted for 7,624 more violations than in 2022, with increases in all 10 categories.

Although the top violations didn't change, there was some movement within the list. Fall Protection – General Requirements remains the #1 violation for the 13th year in a row, followed by Hazard Communication and Ladders.

- 2. Hazard Communication Standard
- 3. Ladders
- 4. Scaffolding, general requirements, construction
- 5. Powered Industrial Trucks
- 6. Control of Hazardous Energy (Lockout/Tagout)
- 7. Respiratory Protection, general industry
- 8. Fall Protection Training Requirements
- 9. Eye and Face Protection
- 10. Machinery and Machine Guarding
