



## Safety Message of the Day for IMEA Members



### Insulated Jumpers Safety Message

Inspect the mac prior to use. When applying a mac, make sure you know the load current -- then select the proper size.

Make sure connection point of jumper clamp is in right location, clean and tight (do not over-tighten)

Insulation is for accidental brush contact only. If laying a mac across an arm or next to a pole, use a rubber blanket or pole guard between the mac and structure.

Use the shortest length mac for the job. During faults, the slack or loops in the mac will whip around and could cause severe damage or personal harm.

Use Adequate rubber gloves and/or hot sticks must be used when installing or removing jumper clamps.
