### Hazard Assessments Before Electrical Work

Before beginning electrical work:

- Identify all energy sources.
- Review equipment labels and documentation.
- Determine if equipment can be de-energized.
- Establish approach boundaries.
- Select appropriate PPE.
- Discuss hazards during the job briefing.

A proper hazard assessment helps workers understand risks before exposure occurs.

### Questions for the Crew

- What information should be reviewed before opening electrical equipment?
- Who is responsible for ensuring a hazard assessment is completed?

Good planning prevents incidents. Never start electrical work without understanding the hazards.
