Monday: Pre-Lift Planning and Job Hazard Analysis

Plan Every Lift Before It Happens

Points

- Review the lift plan before starting work.
- Identify load weight and verify it is within equipment capacity.
- Inspect the lift path for obstacles, energized conductors, uneven ground, and personnel hazards.
- Determine who will be the designated signal person.
- Verify crane, digger derrick, winch, and rigging capacities.
- Establish exclusion zones around the load.

Reminders

- Never guess load weight.
- Follow manufacturer load charts.
- Stop work if conditions change.
- Ensure all crew members understand their roles.
