Maintain Situational Awareness

Troubleshooting often requires focusing on one specific problem, but don't lose sight of everything happening around you. Be aware of nearby energized lines, traffic, weather conditions, changing work locations, and the movements of your coworkers. Communication is critical—keep everyone informed about what is being tested, what has changed, and when equipment may become energized. Good situational awareness helps prevent secondary incidents while solving the original problem.
