Don't Let Assumptions Become Hazards

Many serious incidents begin with an assumption: "I thought the other crew opened it." "I thought the grounds were installed." "I thought everyone was clear." In a high-risk environment, assumptions create gaps in our defenses. Use clear communication, repeat-backs, job briefings, visual confirmation, and testing to eliminate uncertainty. If something changes during the job - crew members, switching conditions, work location, system configuration, or weather - stop and reassess.

***If you have to assume something is safe, you don't know it's safe.
Verify the condition before continuing.***
