Know Before You Go

Before your hands, tools, bucket, boom, or equipment enter the work zone, ask yourself one question: "Do I know this is safe, or do I just think it is?" Knowing means you can identify exactly what protects you: proper isolation, minimum approach distance, PPE, cover-up, grounding, testing, switching orders, communication, or another established control. If you cannot clearly identify the protection, stop and verify before proceeding. Production pressure, familiarity, and confidence should never determine whether a job is safe.
